And that brings us to the reason for this additional book on purpose. Over the past ten years, I have developed a process to help individuals not only know that God has a purpose for them but will also help them discover and fulfill their God-given purposes in life. God Has a Purpose and Plan for You

You Can Know and Fulfill God's Purpose for Your Life Here on Earth

God has a purpose and plan for everyone here on earth. Yet most people never fulfill that purpose because they have never asked the question, "What is God's purpose and plan for my life?" We all want to be successful and live a life of significance. We desire to make a difference in the world, at least in that part of the world where we do life and have the opportunity to impact the lives of others. You can know God's plan for your life. God wants you to know His purpose for you and for you to fulfill that purpose.

What Is Success?

How do you define success? Everyone wants to be successful. No one wants to be a failure. God has a plan for success for your life and you can discover His plan. Unfortunately, success is largely defined by Hollywood, Madison Avenue and Wall Street. We are constantly bombarded in the media by false images of what success should look like. When easily accessible TV comes to a region of the world, consumerism increases many times over,

even in impoverished countries of the world. We don't know we need what we need until the media tells us we need it!

Many people define success in ways that may not be God's plan for their success.

- Position – being a person of high rank and importance
- Prestige – being famous, a person that others admire
- Power – being a person of great power and influence
- Possessions – having all the fine luxuries of life

Many people have pursued these definitions of success only to become terrible failures.

The basic premise of this book is simple, yet missed by the vast majority of individuals in the world. **God's plan for success and significance in your life is to discover your purpose for being here on earth and fulfill that purpose.**

A recent graduate of nearby Florida Gulf Coast University approached me about participating in a **GPS Life Journey** small group I was about to begin. Typically, the kind of individuals who have been most interested in the **GPS Life Journey** have been older and are approaching the end of their professional careers.

So I asked Robert with considerable curiosity, "Why are you interested in the GPS process?" His candid response alerted me to the fact that the **GPS Life Journey** is for anyone. Robert replied, "I have watched my Christian parents pursue the fabled American dream only to wake up from a nightmare of worldly success and broken relationships. I do not want to follow that path. I want to take the journey to God's success for my life."

God Has a Plan for You

God has a plan for your life. May I refer you again to the Prophet Jeremiah. "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope." (Jeremiah 29:11)

This word of hope came to the people of God in the midst of their darkest hour – during Babylonian captivity after the destruction of their homes and homeland. Even though you may be in the midst of difficulty, God has a plan for you that is good; it will give you a future and hope.

Notice at least four very important facts in this scripture.

- God has a plan for you.
- God knows His plan for you.
- God's plan is for your good, not to harm you.
- God's plan for you is to give you hope and a future.

God knows His plan and purpose for your life. Do you? If you do not, I have good news. You can know His purpose for your life. You cannot invent His purpose. You cannot dream up His purpose. You can only discover His purpose as he reveals it to you. He is not deliberately trying to make it difficult for you to discover your purpose. God not only knows His purpose for your life, He wants you to know your purpose and to be actively engaged in fulfilling it. As a matter of fact, that is why He put you here on earth!

God Had a Plan for You before You Were Born

I believe that God has a special purpose for each of us for which we have been uniquely equipped. We learn this in the Bible in the Apostle Paul's letter to the Ephesians. Most followers

of Jesus Christ are familiar with Ephesians 2:8-9, where Paul declares we receive the salvation of God by grace through faith. Yet most followers of Christ are not familiar with Ephesians 2:10, which tells us, "For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, **which God prepared beforehand**, that we should walk in them." You were created to carry out these good works that God prepared for you, even before you were born!

You are special. God uniquely shaped you for a special purpose – His purpose for your life.

No one is here on earth by accident. Each of us is placed on earth by the providence of an Almighty God, who creates and sustains everyone and everything.

"Well, I'm not so sure I can buy into that," you may be thinking.

"If God has a purpose for my life, why do I often have a sense of emptiness and meaninglessness?"

Maybe it is because you, like the vast majority of other individuals in the world, have not discovered God's special purpose for your life. Significance comes from fulfilling God's will and His plan for your life.

Some people try to find a sense of significance and fulfillment in doing everything. They volunteer for every opportunity and say yes to every request for service. Sadly, they not only still feel unfulfilled, they also feel very tired.

Popular author Henry Blackaby states, "Most Christians are so busy doing the work of the church that they miss the will of God!" That is not to say that church work might not be God's plan for your life. It is saying that doing everything is not God's

will for your life. The key to success is not doing all you can but doing what God specifically designed you to do.

God does have a purpose for your life. He has good works that he designed just for you to do even before you were born. His good works for you are not to do as much as you can but to fulfill His plan. This is God's plan for success and significance for your life.

God Has General Purposes for Everyone

There are some things according to scripture that are God's plan for everyone. For example, God desires that everyone should repent and follow Jesus, obey the commands of His Word, and serve others.

II Peter 3:9, "The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that **all should come to repentance.**"

Deuteronomy 4:2, "You shall not add to the word that I command you, nor take from it, that you may **keep the commandments of the Lord your God** that I command you."

I Peter 4:10, "As each has received a gift, use it to **serve one another**, as good stewards of God's varied grace."

Every follower of Jesus Christ should seek to fulfill God's general purposes for everyone.

God Has a Specific Purpose for You

God has a plan for each of us to bring Him glory while we are here on earth. Certainly fulfilling this purpose includes His general purposes for everyone. But God does not desire that

we should do everything. Jesus Christ, while here on earth, did not attempt to do everything. He did not go around performing every good work that could be done. He did not heal all the sick, feed all those who were hungry or raise all the dead. He did only what the Father showed Him to do. God the Father put Jesus Christ the Son here on earth for a specific purpose.

“The Son can do nothing of his own accord, but only what he sees the Father doing. For whatever the Father does, that the Son does likewise.” (John 5:19) God had specific good works for the Son to do while He was here on earth. Jesus knew and fulfilled God the Father’s purpose for His life.

Neither does God intend for you to do every good work you can while here on earth. That leads to burnout. God desires that you do the good works that He planned beforehand especially for you.

Glory to God in the Highest!

By fulfilling God’s purpose for his coming to earth, Jesus brought glory to God the Father. In Jesus’ conversation with His Father just before going to the cross to pay the sin debt of the entire world, He reported that He had brought glory to God. “I glorified you on earth, **having accomplished the work that you gave me to do.**” (John 17:4)

Jesus knew the Father’s purpose for Him while He was here on earth. He was fully committed to carrying out that mission. By doing so, He accomplished God’s purpose for His coming to earth and thereby brought glory to God. If Jesus Christ brought glory to God the Father while here on earth by accomplishing the work that God gave Him to do, you too will bring glory to God by discovering and fulfilling His specific purpose for you while you are here on earth.

Few Are On Mission

The vast majority of people in this world never discover and engage in their God-designed purposes. It is not that they face “mission impossible,” they simply have no clue about what their missions are. You cannot be on mission if you do not clearly understand what your mission is.

It has been my privilege to serve as a consultant and leadership trainer in a variety of venues. I have helped facilitate training for churches of all sizes, other non-profit organizations, denominational conferences, Christian school leadership conventions and for-profit businesses. While the vast majority of my experience has been in mega-church leadership, I feel like I have a fairly accurate view of what’s going on in many types of organizations of all sizes.

I have discovered one discouraging, common thread that runs through most of these organizations. The vast majority of individuals never discover and engage in fulfilling God’s purposes for their lives.

I have consistently surveyed leaders about personal mission for over 30 years. When I ask, "How many of you can stand up right now and clearly state your personal mission statement?" less than 2% of Christian leaders in ministry or in business ever respond positively. Most of those who do respond are quoting a corporate mission statement for which they have little passion and commitment.

Not only do leaders not have a personal mission statement, they have never even given the subject a passing thought. If this is true of leaders, how much more true is it for followers?

Let's test my theory. Do you know your personal God-given mission? Can you state it instantly and clearly without having to go find it written somewhere in the archives? Does it drive your life behavior and your daily decision making? Are you passionate about it?

Little Standards Lead to Little Success

I am afraid that Christian leaders have unintentionally given people in our organizations a weak standard for Christian living. By where we place our priority focus we have led people to believe that the essence of living the Christian life is faithful attendance in our organizations, serving in some volunteer capacity and giving to support the work of our organizations. Of course there is nothing wrong with these activities. The problem is people believing that this is all there is to living a life of success and significance. By setting our standards so low, we have led people to be satisfied with busyness rather than being fulfilled in following God's plan for their lives.

Bob was my Job (Old Testament character Job). I would gladly have held him up to all others and proclaimed. "Have you considered my servant Bob?" Bob did everything. He was incredible! He taught Sunday School, served as a deacon, tithed (That alone made him a saint in my book.), shared his faith, sung in the choir, and volunteered for many special projects.

I was shocked when he solemnly approached me with a look of doom and gloom and said, "We have to talk." Comfortably seated in my office he continued, "I am not happy. I am not fulfilled. I am working as hard as I can but I still feel like God has something else, something different for me. I have no passion, other than obedience, for doing all that I am doing." As it turns out, he was not even being obedient. He was serving because of needs and not as a result of God's calling for his life.

Today I am happy to report that after Bob discovered his God-given gifts and abilities and his God-given purpose he is happily and successfully serving as the directional leader for an extremely prominent mega-church. His business background and passion for developing and encouraging leaders was what he was created for and he is loving every moment of his service for the Kingdom now.

Where Are You on Your Journey?

_____ 10. I am currently engaged in activities that are fulfilling my life purpose, giving me a great sense of significance, and making a difference in the world.

How Did You Do?

Let me give you hope. Typically when individuals take this assessment before participation in the **GPS Life Journey** process, the average score is in the low to mid twenties. After completing the **GPS Life Journey**, scores range in the low to mid forties.

You do not have to go through life not knowing your mission. Remember, God has a plan for you and He knows what it is. (Jeremiah 29:11) God is not deliberately hiding His plan for your life. As a matter of fact, He strongly desires for you to know and fulfill your mission. That is what He made you for and what brings Him the greatest glory.

Rather than only playing golf and sitting on the beach as most retired business professionals do in Florida, Jerry is leaving a legacy of significance. The answer to many of his prayers has been for him to also engage in ministry in many impoverished nations as well as in his own community.

Rescuing Individuals from Human Trafficking

Retired realtors, Lowell and Sally, established the only “safe house” in their state for caring for girls rescued from human trafficking. Their mission rescues and restores to a healthy lifestyle people from the sex trade. They minister in this arena both locally through their safe house and globally through partner organizations with similar purposes. When called to such a passion, their response was, “We are too old and too broke for this mission.” Yet, their obedience to

Shape Up and Ship Out

As mentioned earlier, Christians of the world are greatly indebted to Rick Warren and his best selling book, ***The Purpose Driven Life***. This book introduced the SHAPE concept. Actually, it was introduced in his previous book, ***The Purpose Driven Church***.

SHAPE is an acronym for

- Spiritual Gifts
- Heart or Passions
- Abilities or Strengths
- Personality or Temperament
- Experiences

God has designed or shaped each one of us with a unique profile. While many of us share common characteristics, still we are all different. If every snowflake is created uniquely, certainly every person is unique. We have already discovered that God has a special work for each of us to do. (Ephesians 2:10) God also equips each of us with the gifts to carry out these good works He has assigned to us.

The entire Body of Christ (His Church) benefits from each of us fulfilling His purposes in His Kingdom. (Ephesians 4:12)

In reality then, each Christian is to “shape up and ship out.” That is, each of us must discover and understand our God-given SHAPE and employ that in service in the Kingdom of God. God did not create us just so we could know our uniqueness, but that we might bring glory to Him using our personal profiles in ministry.

What SHAPE Are You In?

Spiritual Gifts

Here is a listing of Spiritual Gifts Listed in Scripture.
(I Corinthians 12, Romans 12, Ephesians 4)

Administration - The ability to organize and think strategically

Apostleship - The passion to begin new works and ministries

Discernment - The ability to test the genuineness of something or someone

Evangelism - The ability to easily share the gospel and lead others to Christ

Exhortation - The ability to encourage others with the truths of scripture

Faith - The ability to trust God in very difficult circumstances

Giving - The desire to give generously to meet needs beyond the biblical teaching of giving 10%

Healing - The faith to see people healed because of your prayers

Interpretation of Tongues - The ability to interpret what another is saying in tongues

Knowledge - The desire to learn and study resulting in an accumulation of knowledge

Leadership - The ability to inspire and cast vision for the big picture and future direction

Prophecy - The passion to speak truth in all situations with boldness and biblical clarity

Mercy - The ability to sympathize with others who have needs

Miracles - The ability to trust God to do miraculous things through your prayers and ministry

Service - The desire to serve others and meet their needs behind the scene

Shepherding - The ability to care for and mentor others using biblical principles

Teaching - The desire to search out and teach biblical truths to others

Tongues - The ability to speak in an unknown tongue or to easily learn other languages

Wisdom - The ability to know the wise thing to do in life situations

What are your primary spiritual gifts?

Heart or Passions

What things, causes, ministries, problems, or dreams excite you the most? What would you do if you could do anything? What problems would you solve in society if you could?

Abilities or Strengths

What are your greatest natural abilities? What skills have you developed because of special training? What are your greatest strengths? What things are you really good at?

The four primary personality types are Dominate, Influence, Steadiness and Conscientiousness.

Dominate - Task-oriented, bold, likes to be in charge

Influence - People-oriented, inspirational, creative, fun-loving

Conscientiousness - Task-oriented, perfectionist, systematic

Getting Your Purpose from God

Can You Hear Me Now?

For many years as a Christian leader, I was guilty of telling people “what” they should be doing as a follower of Christ without helping them to understand “how” they could do it. Most people really do want to do what they know they should be doing. They simply do not know how to do it.

I have made another discovery about Christians. We do not know how to hear from God and get His plan and direction for our lives. So when people hear a leader proclaim that they should hear and obey God, they are eager to do so but do not know how to hear from God.

We cannot live our lives in accordance with His plan and purpose for us if we do not know how to hear Him. I have had the privilege of having Dr. Henry Blackaby, author of **Experiencing God**, as a personal mentor for many years. I have heard Dr. Blackaby say numerous times, “If Christians do not know when God is speaking, they are in trouble at the heart of their Christian lives.”

Even Jesus insisted that he needed direction from the Father and that He did only what He saw the Father doing around Him. (John 5:19-20) Jesus also taught us that real sheep know His voice and follow Him. (John 10:3-4)

A Personal Story

May I share just one personal story of hearing from God concerning His plan for my life?

Several years ago I thought I had arrived at the apex of my career. I was serving as Executive Pastor of a wonderful church and loving what I was doing. We had helped lead a four year process of relocating the church and building a beautiful 100 acre campus.

“This is it,” I told my wife. “I have worked hard for over 30 years. We now have the privilege of serving in a great church in the paradise of Southwest Florida. I am going to slow down a bit, play more golf and enjoy the journey.”

A word of warning - if you plan to take your ease and enjoy the bigger barns that you have built, don't go abroad and see what God is doing around the world. Well, that was my mistake, or I should say, that was my destiny.

I traveled to an impoverished region in the Caucasus Mountains of Southern Russia on a mission trip. While there a local pastor wanted to show me his numerous church plants in this difficult Muslim region.

Upon arriving at one of his new churches, I realized that these deeply committed Christians were meeting in a former chicken house. The chicken wire still covered the windows.

Plastic sheeting had been stretched over the wire to keep out the bitter cold Russian winter winds. Wooden benches without backs sat on the dirt floor. The ceiling was too low for me to stand up inside the building. It is a huge understatement to say it did not resemble “my church.”

The Holy Spirit began to bring to me what well-known pastor and author, Bill Hybels, calls a “holy discontent.” I realized that God was doing so much around the world with so little. I sensed that God was calling me to leave the comfortable ministry that I felt I deserved to fulfill a different purpose for the next stage of my life. It was a struggle to give up my plan for God's plan.

Early one Monday morning while thinking about the need to mobilize others to get involved in meaningful ministry in the Kingdom of God, I informed God, “Somebody ought to do something about this need.” That was another mistake. God quickly responded, “And who would that be that should do something about this?” The answer was obvious.

That morning I knew that my journey was taking a new direction. God was speaking to me and directing me to begin this new venture called Kingdom Mobilization. (www.kingmo.org)

Hearing from God may change your life. Actually, it will change your life! You may have to make adjustments, weather a crisis of belief and experience some sacrifices, but you will never regret that you followed God's plan and purpose for your life.

Yes, my golf game stinks. But the blessing of seeing hundreds of individuals living out their God-given missions is a fragrant sacrifice before the Lord.

What Is Your Experience in Hearing God?

Does God speak to you and give you direction for your life? If you cannot hear from God concerning direction for your life, how do you make crucial decisions?

I know that God definitely does speak to me and gives me direction for my life. There are two primary reasons why I know this. First, it is the record of scripture. God consistently spoke to individuals throughout scripture and gave them direction for their lives.

Second, it is the testimony or personal experience of my life. God has spoken and continues to speak to me concerning His plan for my life. I could write a large volume of illustrations on how God has spoken to me throughout my spiritual journey.

If you cannot hear and get direction from God for your life, there is only one other alternative for your decision making. You figure it out the best you can with your own abilities. Or, you have someone else help you figure it out with the best of their abilities. Either way that is the basis for humanism - the best mankind can do on their own. History reveals to us that this has not worked so well.

It Takes Time

Take the time necessary to hear from God. Hearing from God cannot be rushed. While God may seldom give you direction according to your desired schedule, He is never late. When God appears to be silent, realize that silence is also direction. When God is silent continue to do what He told you to do last and faithfully seek to learn what He is seeking to teach you during the period of silence.

Learn to Listen

If you are having difficulty hearing from God and getting direction for your life, focus your prayers on listening to God rather than talking to God. It is difficult to hear anyone else speak when you are talking.

Creating Margin in Life

Detour Ahead

Several years ago we were traveling from Asheville, North Carolina on I-40 back to East Tennessee where we lived at the time. It was the proverbial "dark and stormy night." We were driving late at night and it had been raining for days. Just west of Asheville we encountered a roadblock and detour sign. Those of you who are familiar with this section of interstate know that it is frequently closed because of rock slides.

We were re-routed over the mountains along narrow, extremely winding roads. We added to a "dark and stormy night" "a long and winding road." What should have been a two-hour journey turned into a stressful, four-hour nightmare.

This is how it is in life when we seek to follow God's plan for our lives. The end result is a wild, exciting adventure. But most journeys in life have detours. Even when we know His purpose and are committed to fulfilling it, we encounter detours.

I have discovered that there are three major roadblocks or detours on the journey to discovering and fulfilling God's

purpose for your life. These roadblocks are a lack of time, a lack of resources, and a lack of spiritual capacity.

Success Is Seeking First Things First

Success in life is not related to your getting “caught up.” It is about doing first things first. Being able to have the resources for fulfilling your mission is not merely about accumulating excess funds for ministry. It is about prioritizing the use of all the resources that God provides. Having spiritual capacity to lead and serve in meaningful ministry is not accomplished by just attending church. It is the natural overflow of pursuing an intimate relationship with Jesus Christ.

In short, you must create intentional time and financial margins and spiritual capacity in your life. Are you using your time, financial resources and spiritual capacity for maximum impact in the Kingdom of God?

Discovering and fulfilling your God-given mission is not about getting caught up or finally have excess time and money; it is about placing first things first.

Creating Time Margin

- How much time can you devote to pursuing your life purpose?
- What do you need to change in order to have time margin to pursue your mission?
- Are you willing to do first things first and leave undone other good things to pursue your life purpose? Why or why not?

Creating Financial Margin

- How much money can you devote to pursuing your life purpose?
- What do you need to change in order to have financial margin to pursue your mission?
- Are you willing to place first things first in the use of your financial resources? Why or why not?

Creating Spiritual Capacity

- How are you doing on your spiritual journey? Do you have spiritual capacity to lead or serve others?
- What do you need to change to have greater spiritual capacity?
- Are you willing to make your spiritual capacity a priority in your personal growth? Why or why not?

Detour End

Remember, you have all the time, financial resources and spiritual capacity necessary to fulfill your God-given purpose. God has given you all you need to follow His plan for your life. The key is to prioritize - make first things first.

Appendix E ... The Tombstone Legacy Activity

The purpose of the Tombstone Legacy Activity is to help you to understand and reflect on the legacy you are leaving for others.

Draw a tombstone on a piece of paper.

Put your name on the top of the tombstone as it will be listed after your death. Put your date of birth followed by tomorrow's date as the date of your death on the bottom of the tombstone.

Now, write words and/or short phrases in between your name and these dates that describe how you think you will be remembered by others, if your death were tomorrow. How would people describe you? What would people say about you?

Next, take another piece of paper and draw a second tombstone. Place your name on the top and change the date of your death on the bottom to 100 years after your birth.

Again, write in words and/or short phrases that you would like to have as your legacy after your death. What would you desire people say about you?

Compare the two tombstones. Are they similar? Are they very different? Are you satisfied with what is listed as your legacy on the first tombstone? If not, how can you change your legacy? It is never too late to change your legacy.

You may want to look at the Alfred Nobel story at the Wikipedia website to see how one person intentionally, totally changed his legacy.
